

# D.S.A INSTRUCTOR COURSE

## Aims & Objectives:

To ensure that the candidate is of the required standard to pass the D.S.A Driving Ability test and possess the adequate skills in instruction required to pass the test of instructional ability.

## Who can apply:

The licence regulations require that accompanying drivers in all category vehicles must have held a full, unrestricted driving licence in the applicable category, for three years.

The candidate must not have been disqualified from driving at any time in the four years prior to registration.

All convictions including motor offences still in force i.e. not spent under the rehabilitation act 1974 will be taken into account when the initial application is considered.

**Course Duration:** The average duration is 10 Days which is confirmed on completion of the driving assessment.

Driving ability test to take place on the fifth day of training, with the Instructional ability test to take place on the tenth day.

**Course Times:** 8.30am until 5.00pm

## Course Content:

Training Days 1 - 5: Re-addressing the driving techniques and procedures of the candidate's road craft skills.

Training Days 6 - 10: Core Competence  
Instructional Techniques  
Instructor Characteristics
